2023/24 Summary

Summary of posts – 2023/24

- London were allocated 58 expansion posts for 2023.
- Distribution loss of 48.
- There is an overall net gain of 10 posts for London.

- Consultant behaviours

Workforce Transformation

- Focus needs to be on wider workforce optimisation
- Specialty training schools, DMEs and service leads to start to think about mitigation for post losses.
- Engagement has been ongoing with ICBs to support these conversations.



2024 and beyond

London distribution plan – 2024/25

- London have been allocated 95 of 877 (10.8%) total expansion posts for 2024.
- 95 expansion posts confirmed across 34 specialties.
- Distribution loss of 42





Figure 2: Doctors joining the workforce by PMQ region per year


