Description of Unit
<p>St Mary's Hospital is the major acute hospital for northwest London as well as a maternity centre with consultant and midwife-led services. The hospital provides care across a wide range of specialties and runs one of four major trauma centres in London in addition to its 24/7 A&E department. We are a major provider of education and training for doctors, nurses, midwives and allied health professionals including therapists, pharmacists, radiographers and healthcare scientists. St Marys is a part of Imperial College Healthcare NHS Trust, whose 14,500 staff treat over a million patients a year and serve a local population of 2.4 million people, including those living in some of the UK's most deprived boroughs.</p> <p><u>Specialist Gynaecology services</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gynaecology emergency service • Reproductive medicine (sub-specialty training approved) and IVF • Fibroid management • Recurrent miscarriage • Acute gynaecology and early pregnancy assessment • Colposcopy • Urogynaecology (sub-specialty training approved) • Minimal Access • OP hysteroscopy -1000 per annum • Complex abortion care – appr 800 women per year with 250 beyond 14 weeks • Menopause clinics. <p>The Gynaecology Emergency service is delivered at St Marys Hospital and treats approximately 7,000 patients per annum on a walk-in and GP/Consultant referral basis. Specialist diagnostic scanning and treatment is offered 7 days per week to all pregnant women under 20 weeks and for all non-pregnancy related gynaecological emergencies. We also performed around 150 MVA per year.</p> <p>The Colposcopy service receives 2700 new referrals to the St Mary's site. The out-patient hysteroscopy / cystoscopy service manages over 1500 cases annually across site. Specialist fertility services see over 11000 women with urogynaecology seeing over 5000 per year.</p> <p>The Gynaecology emergency service, across the Trust, sees over 13000 women annually admitting 1500 emergencies. The Termination of pregnancy service provides 800 abortions annually in dedicated facilities it is one of 5 national providers for complex TOP. The combined Gynaecology services perform at least 3000 surgeries annually and with at least 66%-day case rate. St Marys is BSGE accredited provider for complex endometriosis care.</p> <p><u>Maternity Services</u></p> <p>Maternity at St Marys has been awarded a "Outstanding" rating overall and for all categories (safe, effective, caring responsive and well led) in the CQC inspection reported in October 2019.</p>

St Marys supports a midwifery-led birth centres. Specialist services are offered include:

- Maternal Medicine
- Fetomaternal medicine
- High risk pregnancy
- Caseload midwifery in vulnerable women and teenage pregnancy

Level 2 neonatal facilities are based at St Mary's.
